

Mini Quilts for HAVQG Auction

The HAVQG quilt show is less than a year away, and it is time for you to start thinking about the mini quilt that you plan to donate for our auction. The auction at the last quilt show was very successful and we had almost 60 mini quilts donated for auction.

Guidelines:

- Mini quilts should be 30" or smaller on their longest side.
- Quilts do not have to be square. Be creative and think about a rectangular, hexagonal, triangular or round shape.
- Quilts may be hand or machine quilted.
- Embellishments are acceptable and encouraged.
- A sleeve should be attached to the back of the quilt.
- A label with the maker's name and the name of the quilt should be attached to the back of the quilt. If you don't name your quilt, we will name it prior to the auction.
- Please complete the attached form and pin it to your quilt with a safety pin when you turn it in.
- All quilts should be finished and handed in by the February meeting. We will accept quilts starting with the September 2010 meeting.
